AKCHO AWARDS INFORMATION

It's AKCHO Awards time and we invite you to submit nominations in the following categories:

-
- **LONG TERM PROJECT AWARD** – Presented to an organization for an outstanding landmark restoration, ongoing or long-term project such as a video, slide show, oral history, development of a new organization, or similar long-impact or permanent projects, (traditional & technical).
 - **SINGLE IMPACT EVENT AWARD** – Presented to an organization for an outstanding one time or single series educational program, performance, lecture series, fund raising event, workshop or similar single impact event.
 - **EXHIBIT AWARD** – Presented to an organization for an outstanding permanent, traveling, outreach, or temporary display or exhibit of any size that uses historical collections as the educational source material.
 - **YOUTH AWARD** – Presented to a King County student (K-12) who has made an outstanding contribution to the heritage community with service or through a project that has benefited the community at large.
 - **HERITAGE EDUCATION AWARD** – Presented to a King County teacher or an organization who has promoted King County heritage by the innovative incorporation of local history into the curriculum and/or through a project that involves students with the heritage community.
 - **WILLARD JUE MEMORIAL AWARD** – Presented to individuals in two possible categories – paid staff and volunteers. The Willard Jue Memorial Award winners are individuals who have made outstanding contributions, provided exceptional leadership, and demonstrated excellence in duration, quality, or spirit of service.
 - **VIRGINIA MARIE FOLKINS AWARD** – Presented to the author and/or sponsoring organization of an outstanding historical publication
 - **CHARLES PAYTON AWARD FOR HERITAGE ADVOCACY** – Presented to an individual or an organization that has initiated, developed, or presented a plan which has led to the advancement of funding for heritage projects, protections of heritage resources, or public awareness for heritage, such as posters, videos, newsletters, or web-sites, etc.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Nominations are open to the public and neither nominators nor nominees need to be AKCHO members. Nominations should reflect an exceptional contribution to King County's heritage community or to King County's history.
- The activities for which nominations are made must have been **completed by December 31, 2009**, and must have been held within and for the benefit of King County and/or its constituent communities.
- Individuals who are serving as active AKCHO Board members ARE NOT eligible to be nominated for individual AKCHO awards. The organizations that are represented by current individual Board members ARE eligible to be nominated.

IN ADDITION:

- Individuals may not nominate themselves, but may be nominated by a beneficiary of their services, co-workers, or other knowledgeable persons.
- Organizations' programs, exhibits, publications, etc., may be nominated by someone within that organization, such as a Board member, volunteer, staff member, etc.
- Organizations/Individuals may be nominated in more than one category.
- Former recipients may be nominated for new contributions to the heritage community; but are not eligible for an additional award for a previously acknowledged activity, event, or contribution
- Entries will not be considered for judging if received after the **deadline date of February 15, 2010**.
