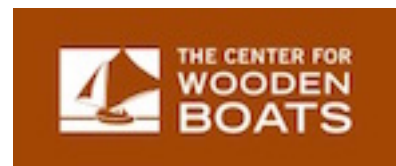

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

The Northwest African American Museum is located on the corner of 23rd Avenue and S Massachusetts Street, just south of downtown Seattle. Free parking is available on site. Please make sure to use only the spaces marked for the Museum, or you also can find several parking spaces at Jimi Hendrix Park, immediately east of the Museum's parking lot. There is ample street parking as well.

Traveling north:

- I-5 North, merge onto I-90 E via EXIT 164A toward SPOKANE.
- Take EXIT 3, the RAINIER AVENUE S exit, and turn right onto Rainier Avenue.
- Go one block and turn left (east) on S Massachusetts Street, and the Museum is three blocks up on the left.

Traveling south:

- I-5 South, merge onto I-90 E via EXIT 164 toward BELLEVUE/SPOKANE.
- Take EXIT 3, the RAINIER AVENUE S exit, and turn right onto Rainier Avenue.
- Go one block and turn left (east) on S Massachusetts Street, and the Museum is three blocks up on the left.

Traveling west:

- I-90 West, Take EXIT 3A, the RAINIER AVENUE S exit.
- Turn slight right onto Rainier Avenue.
- Turn left (east) on S Massachusetts Street, and the Museum is three blocks up on the left.

PUBLIC TRANSIT

The #48 bus stops very near the Northwest African American Museum, at 23rd Ave S & S Massachusetts St, and runs about every 20 minutes in the afternoon and evening. You can take the #48 south from the U District, or take the #7 from downtown and transfer to the #48 at the Mt. Baker Transit Center.
